## What is happening?

The purpose of the Public Informational Meeting is to solicit input from the public regarding the width of a proposed sidewalk or shared-use path along South Street, Main Street, and Sisson Road in the vicinity of Harwich Elementary School. All views and comments made at the meeting will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

## How will this affect you?

The existing sidewalks are too narrow to accommodate the current pedestrian demand and there are no bicycle accommodations. The Project will improve accessibility for these modes of travel for students walking to and from the Harwich Elementary School. The proposed accommodations will also serve as a connection to the Cape Cod Rail Trail via Island Pond Road.
