

ROAD CONSTRUCTION NOTICES

- Mass Highway Department is reconstructing the intersection of Route 124 and Queen Anne Road. Work is scheduled from April 1, 2009 to June 19, 2009, and then between September 8, 2009 and April 1, 2010, with completion scheduled prior to Memorial Day 2010.
- Harwich Highway Department is scheduled to resurface Sea Street and Gilbert Lane (South Street to Doane Road) on June 4, 2009. Division Street is scheduled for resurfacing on June 5, 2009.
- Beach Plum Circle, Wales Road, Popple Grove Road and all roads connecting these roads are scheduled for chip sealing starting June 9, 2009, with completion scheduled by June 10, 2009. Frances Road, Ryder Road, Juniper Lane, Marie Lane, Denise Lane, Kendall Lane, and Rose Lane are also scheduled for chip sealing at the same time.
- Pleasant Bay Road and Lothrop Avenue are scheduled for micro-surfacing this season, but an exact date has not yet been determined. This process calls for lane closures and it is imperative that vehicles stay off the affected areas until the coating dries. All efforts will be made to inform residents and users of these roads when the work dates will be. Also, Main Street (from Depot Street to Great Western Road) will be redone, as flaws were discovered in the process from last year.
